The **Connecticut Neighborhood Assistance Act** (NAA) Tax Credit Program is designed to fund municipal and tax-exempt organizations by providing a corporation business tax credit for businesses that make cash contributions to these entities.

Mutual Housing Association of Southwestern Connecticut, DBA Connecticut Housing Partners anticipates being allocated \$150,000 in energy conservation tax credits through the Neighborhood Assistance Act by the Department of Revenue Services.

Your company could deduct these Tax Credits from the amount of tax owed rather than your income on a dollar-for-dollar basis and realize significant savings at tax time!

To attain these Tax Credits, we are looking to companies to:

- Invest in an amount of up to \$150,000 to support essential repairs and energy conservation improvements at four of our affordable housing developments for low-income households.
- **The Projects Include:**
 - **Wilton Commons** – Samsung Units replacement with Energy Efficiency systems
 - **Approved for \$52,000**
 - **Clinton Commons Bridgeport** – Energy Efficiency Upgrades
 - **Approved for \$118,900**
 - **Woodward Cliffs Norwalk** – Wall/piping to divert flooding and Front Porch Repair/replacement
 - **Approved for \$38,500**
 - **Trinity Park Stamford** – Energy Efficiency Upgrades
 - **Approved for \$48,500**
- **Total: \$258,400**
- Be a business firm that is authorized to do business in Connecticut and subject to the Insurance Premiums Tax (Chapter 207), Corporation Business Tax (Chapter 208), the Public Services Companies taxes (chapters 209, 210, 211 and 212) or the Business Entity Tax (Chapter 213a).

By supporting this program, your organization will benefit with a tax credit and reduce your tax liability and you will also be helping these disadvantaged families by allowing us to continue to provide a safe and healthy environment for our residents and making their energy bills more affordable.

To help, complete and submit the Connecticut Neighborhood Assistance Act Form which **will open on September 15. The deadline to submit is October 1, 2022.**
